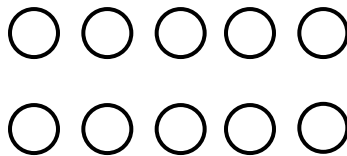
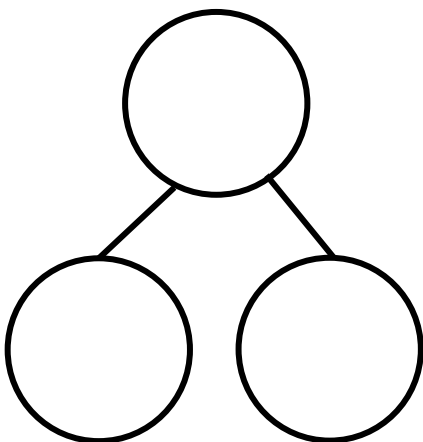
Fill in the number bond and number sentence. Cross off the part that goes away.

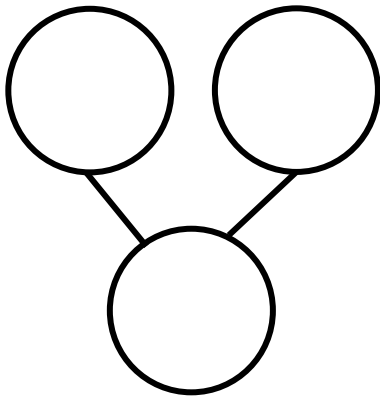

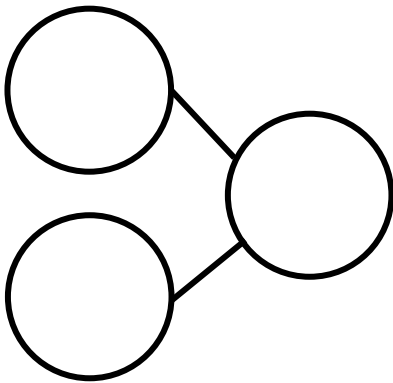
